4 THE DEFENDANT: Uh-huh.

5 THE COURT: Okay. Now, Mr. Gamble, you're  
6 already suffering from this now, so I've got to explain it

8 What you're pleading to today is a robbery, and  
9 that's what is known as a serious felony, which means  
10 this: That if you get arrested and charged with another  
11 serious felony in the future, for example another robbery  
12 or a residential burglary or assault with a deadly weapon  
13 with use or whatever, the fact that you've been convicted  
14 of this offense means that if the other case, your new  
15 case, gets charged in the future, if you happen to get  
16 arrested and convicted in the future on a serious felony  
17 and the judge in this case decides to send you to prison,  
18 he is going to have to add five years to your sentence for  
19 this case today.

20 And because you already have two prior serious  
21 felonies, the residential burglary and the assault with a  
22 deadly weapon with a use clause, you're talking about 15  
23 years in prior offenses.

24 You understand that, Mr. Gamble?

25 THE DEFENDANT: Yeah.


26 THE COURT: Okay. Also, there's a minimum \$100
